Who can become a Habitat for Humanity Homeowner?

To be considered, applicants must:

- Have lived or worked in Whitman or Latah County for at least the past year;
- Live in inadequate housing (ex. problems with heating, structural issues, excessive rent or utility bills, etc);
- Fulfill partnership obligations, including 300-500 hours of “sweat equity” helping build the home;
- Fall within the respective income category listed below;
- Meet other financial selection criteria;
- Attend an information or help session to learn about the program
