To be considered, applicants must:

- *Have lived or worked in Latah or Whitman County for at least the past year;
- *Have gross income within the 30-60% AMI range (see below);
- *Live in inadequate housing (ex: structural problems, high rent cost, crowding, etc.);
- *Fulfill partnership obligations, including 300-400 hours of "sweat equity" helping build the home;
- *Meet other financial criteria;
- *Attend an informational meeting session to learn about the Habitat Homeowner Program:
