Mission to Puerto Rico—January 2019

Two families in Puerto Rico now know what it is like to have a roof over their heads thanks to 14 volunteers and five days of blood sweat and tears. We made a very small dent in a very huge problem. During Hurricane Maria, just over a year and a half ago, many homes were completely destroyed and over 60,000 homes lost their roofs. Our group, sponsored by Moscow First Methodist Church, worked on two homes. We completed two roofs, including trusses on one, painted both homes, installed siding, helped with electrical and did a whole bunch of plaster repairs. One of the most rewarding parts of the trip was the hugs of appreciation from the families. I am so impressed with the resilience of the Puerto Rican people. There is still thousands of blue tarps, many of the people I talked with were without power for months and many had no running water for weeks, yet I never heard anyone complain. Just the opposite, they were all very gracious, appreciative and welcoming. I can't say enough about the group of volunteers who spent their own time and money to make a difference in other people's lives. We started as strangers and ended as family. We shared a lot together as a group, work, meals, stories and tears, but the one thing we will always remember is knowing that we were able to help someone less fortunate than us.
