Palouse Habitat for Humanity is Hiring its First Americorps Member!

Moscow, Idaho. (April 4, 2024) — Make an impact in the community! Palouse Habitat for Humanity has partnered with Habitat Americorps to hire a Construction Crew Leader. The Construction Crew Leader will be a full-time Americorps member who will learn professional skills through hands-on work over the course of a year. They will grow to lead volunteers to build affordable homes and perform home repairs.

The Americorps member will:

- Typically work Tuesday – Saturday on the home build site.
- Assist with all aspects of hands-on construction tasks including demolition, site prep, framing, insulation, drywall, flooring, roofing, finish carpentry and landscaping.
- Participate in new construction, rehabilitation, critical home repair and weatherization projects.
- Lead small groups of volunteers and ensure a positive experience for everyone.
- Maintain site safety by adhering to Habitat construction safety policies, modeling best practices and guidelines, volunteer education and site monitoring.
