Just last year the ReStore:


- repurposed 342,000 pounds of material and kept it out of our landfills.
- provided 11,000 community members with affordable home improvement items.
- AND raised \$263,000 to support Palouse Habitat's home building and repair programs!

Those funds helped build the Aimee Martinez home, AND 39 ramp and repair projects.

We are in the Home Stretch - the final steps are underway to finish the ReStore repair and remodel project we started in 2019. The ReStore is our largest single fundraiser, and with the changes we've made, we're counting on it to help Palouse Habitat build and repair even more homes for our neighbors in need.

But we need your help! We still have to raise the final \$170,000 of the total \$1.5 million project.
