-The policy should incorporate the value of the home build experience, of the future homeowner working alongside community volunteers, and balance with recognition of the burden sweat equity hours can place on the future homeowner.

-The policy should comply with HFHI policy.

It should meet the three important HFHI goals of:

- Partnership
- Pride in Homeownership
- Development of skills and knowledge about the home.

Practice:

-Future Homeowner will report hours to the Habitat office. They will alert Habitat office to any Friends and Family who are contributing hours.
