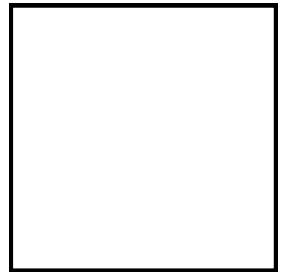

Prairie Ave, Uniontown, WA

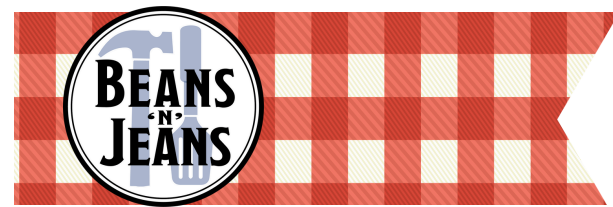

Brice McLaughlin

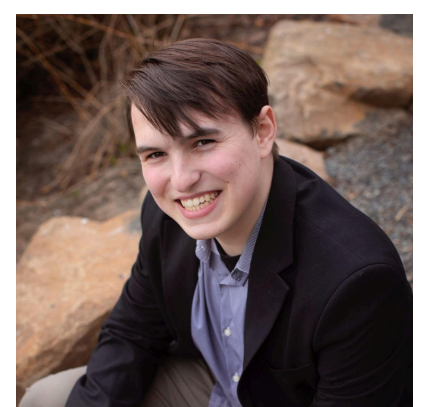
ReStore Assistant Manager
